Keçi Castle

The date of construction and the builder of this castle, which is located 20 km east of Gümüşhane city center and right of the Gümüşhane-Bayburt highway, are not known. It is thought that the castle was most probably an important military base in the region, securing the roads of Gümüşhane, Bayburt and Kelkit.



The castle, which stands 800 meters high on a flat rock mass, was built on a large rock block with a 1560-meter altitude above sea level. The castle has two separate entrances at the western and eastern sections. Next to the western entrance, which is estimated to be the main entrance, there is a 15-meter shelter made of natural rock.

There are water cisterns and some places considered to be warehouses at the northern and southern sections of the castle. To the west, there is a two-floor bastion considered to have been built as a prison, with a window opening to the east on the upper floor. There are also several ways descending
